DISCUSSION

Discussion of Navarre Beach Department truck replacement.

BACKGROUND

The oldest Navarre Beach trash/maintenance truck is a 1990 Chevrolet pickup (#773) transferred from Public Works motor pool to Navarre Beach on 10/26/09. This 25 year old vehicle recently died and is rusted beyond repair. Navarre Beach personnel contacted the county shop about any surplus 4X4 trucks and informed one is not available. A replacement truck will be placed into utility operations and NB Department will re-assign its oldest vehicle (2004 Ford F150 4X4) to beach trash/maintenance. Hub City Ford has agreed to honor the November 17, 2015 lowest bid price of \$22,496 for a 4X4 truck meeting bid specifications.

Board approve the purchase of a replacement truck for Navarre Beach Department from Hub City Ford at previous bid price of \$22,496.00 meeting previous bid specifications.
