MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS
¾ TON REGULAR CAB LWB 4X2 PICKUP TRUCK

GENERAL:

It is the intent of these specifications to describe a ¾ TON REGULAR CAB LWB 4X2 PICKUP TRUCK in sufficient detail to secure bids on comparable equipment. All parts not specifically mentioned, which are necessary to provide a complete and operational ¾ TON REGULAR CAB LWB 4X2 PICKUP TRUCK, shall be included in the bid and shall conform in strength and quality of material and workmanship to what is usually provided to the trade in general. The truck shall be the latest model, new currently advertised, heavy-duty standard production unit with all standard equipment.

Any units not conforming to the intent of these specifications may be rejected, and it will be the responsibility of the manufacturer to conform to the requirements unless any / all exceptions to this bid have been specifically cited by the bidder and acceptance made on the basis of the exception. Bidder is required to meet or exceed each and every item listed below.

ENGINE:

1. Manufacturer's standard 8 Cylinder Gas.
2. Heavy duty alternator, heavy duty battery.
3. Increased capacity cooling system; permanent type anti-freeze.

TRANSMISSION:

1. Manufacturer's standard Automatic transmission.
2. Heavy duty transmission oil cooler.

AXLES:

1. Manufacturer's standard ratio rear axel for specified engine, transmission combination.

PERFORMANCE:

1. Manufacturer's standard power steering.

The term "affiliate" includes those officers, directors, executives, partners, shareholders, employees, members, and agents who are active in the management of an affiliate. The ownership by one person of shares constituting a controlling interest in another person, or a pooling of equipment or income among persons when not for fair market value under an arm's length agreement, shall be a prima facie case that one person controls another person. A person who knowingly enters into a joint venture with a person who has been convicted of public entity crime.
