Free AARP Tax Preparation @ Your Library

It's that time of year again, and three locations in the Santa Rosa County Library System are once again AARP Tax-Aide Sites. The AARP Tax-Aide program is the nation's largest free, volunteer-run tax preparation and assistance service, providing service to millions of low- and middle-income taxpayers, with special attention to those ages 60 and older.

The AARP Tax-Aide program offers free one-on-one counseling to help individuals prepare and file basic tax forms, including the 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ and other standard schedules. No appointment is necessary. Library locations are equipped to file your return electronically, allowing you to receive your return much faster.

Free AARP Tax-Aide Preparation is available February 1 through April 15 at these locations:

- Gulf Breeze Library on Mondays and Thursdays from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and Wednesdays from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Milton Library on Tuesdays from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. and Thursdays from 9 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
- Navarre Library on Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. Saturday service at Navarre Library begins February 13.
