Public Input Sought for Navarre Beach Park Improvements Grant

Santa Rosa County is applying for a Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant to make additional improvements to the sound side area of Navarre Beach Park located at 8704 Gulf Boulevard, Navarre Beach. Improvements currently being considered include boardwalks, dune walkovers, canoe launch, leisure pier, wetland observation deck and educational kiosks. The public is invited to submit comments regarding potential improvements by completing a survey or attending one of two public input meetings.

The grant application will be discussed during the Santa Rosa County Parks and Recreation Committee Meeting on Wednesday, January 26 at 4 p.m. and on Thursday, January 27 at 9:30 a.m. during the public hearing section of the regularly scheduled commission meeting. Both meetings will be held in the board meeting room located at 6495 Caroline Street, Milton.
