Library System Seeks Community Input through Survey

As the Santa Rosa County Library System approaches its five year anniversary this summer, citizen input through an online survey is being sought to help plan services for the next five years. A link to the survey can be found on the library's website at www.santarosa.fl.gov/libraries.

The purpose of the survey is to gather data on use of current library services and programs. With today's shrinking budgets and the need to prioritize use of limited funds, public libraries must be aware of their community needs and desires in order to provide services that will best meet citizens' needs.

The survey seeks responses on citizens' use of library services – in the library or through remote access – including borrowing materials, using free public computers, and attending youth programs. Another area of interest for planning is determining which service categories are most in demand, such as homework and academic research, personal consumer research, or recreational use – along with subjects and topics most used such as hobbies, genealogy, health, travel, business, or financial.
