Navarre Beach is currently number one in the race for the title of America's Best Restored Beach, but the competition is close behind! The runner up is only about 100 votes behind, and to maintain our lead we need continuous voting every day.

You can vote once every 24 hours, up to April 27, online at www.asbpa.org/about_us/about_us_best_restored_beach_2012_community.htm or visit www.santarosa.fl.gov for a link to the voting site. The website has a feature where you can even see how your favorite beach is doing every time you visit. The site allows only one vote per IP address. Most work computers are registered to the same IP address, meaning one computer may vote at that address. If you wish to vote, the best place to do so is on your cell phone, home or personal computer, laptop or iPad.

To celebrate 10 years of honoring Best Restored Beaches Across America, the American Shore & Beach Preservation Association is asking anyone who loves the beach to pick the Best of the Best Restored Beaches from a list of past restored beach award winners. Santa Rosa County urges all to vote for Navarre Beach as Best Community Beach by casting your vote every day from March 30 to April 27.

Winners will be announced mid-May (just in time for the start of the "official" summer beach season). All participating beaches will be honored at a special ceremony next spring during the ASBPA's annual Coastal Summit in Washington, DC.
