



RESTORE Act Projects Blackwater Heritage Trail Infrastructure Improvements

Project Description

This project proposes to repair and stabilize critical areas in need, add a restroom, water fountains, and benches to the Blackwater Heritage State Trail, an 8.1-mile multiple use, linear trail.

In addition to the regular use by both tourists and residents, the trail is being increasingly used for cycling and running events, an important economic driver. Participants who use the trail regularly and visitors alike have communicated the need for additional trail infrastructure to improve the state park.
