Project Description

The goal of this project is to restore the Yellow River Marsh Preserve State Park to more natural environmental conditions. This will be completed through conducting mechanical treatments and prescribed fire to restore a portion of the wet prairie system on Garcon Point. Activities seek to provide adequate habitat for native plant and animal species. These natural communities have been shaped and maintained by periodic fire, which is an important management tool to restore and maintain these natural areas.
