

# YOUR TRAFFIC RESOURCE DURING SEVERE WEATHER



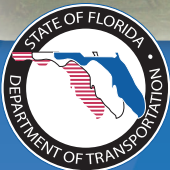
When hurricanes, severe weather and other natural disasters threaten Florida, check the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) 511 Traveler Information System for real-time updates on traffic conditions, including road and bridge closures, evacuation information, congestion, crashes and more.

## How to Get 511 Traffic Information

- » Call 511 toll free for updates in English and Spanish from any landline or mobile phone
- » Visit [FL511.com](http://FL511.com), with interactive roadway maps showing traffic congestion and crashes, travel times and traffic camera views
- » Download the Florida 511 mobile app for free from Google Play or iTunes App Store
- » Follow one of the 12 FL511 statewide, regional or roadway-specific feeds on Twitter

## Be Prepared & Know Before You Go!

- » Check 511 before traveling, have a passenger check 511 or pull over to avoid distracted driving
- » Call 511 before you enter a new roadway to become aware of the current road condition
- » Drive slowly and turn on your lights in low visibility conditions including rain
- » Follow instructions from local officials and law enforcement during evacuations
- » Always wear a seat belt
