RECOMMENDATION

Discussion of additional fees in the amount of \$21,160.00 to Baskerville-Donovan, Inc. for engineering services, topographic and boundary survey. Fee to be reimbursed per HMGP (Hazard Mitigation Grant Program), 75% State, 25% County.

BACKGROUND

The original concept plan for the Chipper Lane/Maranatha Way project utilized a vacant 3.2 acre parcel on the corner of Chipper Lane and Nora Avenue, as a potential location of a stormwater retention pond. Search revealed a February 21, 2001 Final Judgement which states the record title owners of lots in the Thomastown Estates Subdivision have a perpetual right of easement over the property to use as a park. Additional vacant property was found approximately 500 feet north of the original project area.
