SUBJECT: Derelict Vessel Removal Grant Opportunity

RECOMMENDATION

Recommend Board discuss Derelict Vessel Removal Grant Opportunity and provide direction on development of potential grant application.

BACKGROUND

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) is accepting applications for the "Bulk Derelict Vessel Removal Grant Program" through October 27, 2016. Approximately \$1.2 million is available in the current cycle. There is a 25% match requirement which can be met with cash or in-kind resources.


In consultation with Public Works and FWC, we have identified one existing derelict vessel that meets the criteria for the grant program. The FWC Case Number is FWNW-09-OFF-004065 and location and additional details of the vessel are shown on the attached map. This vessel, located at the northern shore of Santa Rosa Sound west of Navarre, and has been in the FWC "Statewide At-Risk and Derelict Vessel Database" since 2009.

A preliminary estimate for removal and disposal of the vessel by a contractor is approximately \$6,000 - \$10,000. Depending on the final project cost, the matching requirement would range from \$1,500-\$2,500. Potential sources of match include Boater Registration Fees and general reserves. Removal of vessels deemed a hazard to public safety and health is an eligible use of vessel registration fees.


FUTURE ACTION

If the board directs staff to develop a grant application to remove the vessel, we will discuss at the October 4th Marine Advisory Committee and request approval of boater registration fees for the match. A final grant application with detailed budget will be presented at the next Commission meeting for approval and the grant will be submitted by the required deadline. If approved, the grant agreement would come to the Board for approval.

DERELICT VESSEL REMOVAL GRANT OPPORTUNITY ANNOUNCEMENT

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) is currently announcing the opportunity to apply for Derelict Vessel Removal Grants. The application period for the Bulk Derelict Vessel Removal Grant Program will begin on September 12, 2016, and end at the close of business on **October 27, 2016**. Applications received before September 12 or after close of business on October 27, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. (ET), will not be eligible for consideration.
