DISCUSSION

Santa Rosa County supported the Northwest Florida All Hazards Incident Management Team's (NWFL AHIMT) deployment to Flagler County to support EOC operations for Hurricane Matthew.

BACKGROUND

The State of Florida has six Incident Management Teams throughout the state, the NWFL AHIMT is composed of members from regions 1 & 2 which covers from Pensacola to Tallahassee. The State EOC received a request for assistance from Flagler County as Hurricane Matthew approached the Florida East coast. Santa Rosa County was able to deploy three of the seven members of the team, Brad Baker (Team Incident Commander), Tom Lloyd (Operations) and Jonathan Kanzigg (Fire Liaison & Logistical Support).
