## Interested In Becoming a Licensed Construction Contractor in Santa Rosa County?

You must have a sponsor to take a construction exam. For a fee of \$50, for each exam registration form completed, Santa Rosa County will be your sponsor.

For more information on the test agency, a registration form, an exam schedule and practice exams you can take, please visit the following website. This site also has bulletins available that outline the reference materials allowed in the testing center for the exam you wish to take. Please note that Santa Rosa County does not issue competency cards for all exams listed, we test under the most current building/electrical codes and have a cutoff rate of 75%.
