Utility Work on I-10 and I-110

Chipley –Gulf Power will perform maintenance on aerial power lines crossing I-10 and I-110 in Escambia and Santa Rosa County. Tuesday, October 13, around 9 a.m. crews will remove the crossing on I-10, just west of the rest area in Santa Rosa County. Wednesday, October 14 around 9 a.m. workers will replace the neutral conductor at I-10 and Robinson Point Road. A rolling road block will be in place as crews complete the work. A rolling roadblock is when traffic is paced at a safe speed (desirably not less than 20 mph on the Interstate) to provide a gap in traffic and allow work activities to be performed. The pacing of traffic is controlled by a pilot vehicle (i.e., law enforcement vehicles with blue lights flashing) driven by uniformed law enforcement personnel.
