Project Information

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is currently working on preliminary plans to design an attractive, user-friendly American with Disabilities Act accessible pedestrian overpass that will provide a safer passage for pedestrians wishing to cross U.S. 98 in the vicinity of Presidio Street and the Navarre Park/Visitors Center. The Navarre Park is home to a splash pad, basketball court, walking trails, and a playground. It is also the location where local festivals, weekly concert series, and community activities are held.

Right-of-way acquisition will be necessary for the construction of this project. Right-of-way nor construction is funded in the FDOT 5-Year Work Program at this time.
